Description of Target groups: Citizens coming from the municipalities, which were represented by partners. Target group consisted of all age groups and most of all ordinary citizens.

Brief description of the project:

The project was implemented through one event that took place on 13-15/10/2022. The content of the project was the implementation of the following activities:

Presentation of the project to the media and the general public - it was a presentation of the project, its goals, planned results and outputs. The CERV program and the financial support of the project from the EU were also presented.

Life with corona - workshop on the impact of the corona crisis on local communities, exchange of experiences. Presentation of good practices in the field of solutions of the COVID-19 pandemic at the local level.

Volunteering as a profession - a discussion with the Marginal Civic Association dedicated to migrants and social inclusion. Presentation of inclusion in practice, overcoming prejudices.

EU against discrimination - presentation of EU's policies in the field of human rights. Incentives for increasing interest in human rights and in documents dealing with human rights at the EU level.

Hello friends - social and dating activities among participants from six countries.

The future of the EU with the smallest - interactive educational activities for children with the theme of the EU.

Minorities in Europe - discussion with the organization Forum: Institute for Minority Research on the topics: life, culture and identity of minorities in EU countries.

Taste Europe - presentation of traditional gastronomy and gastronomic specialties of six European countries.

How further the EU? – a lecture by the EuropeDirect centre on the benefits of the EU for citizens and a discussion on the citizens' view of the EU and the future of Europe.

Creative workshops of solidarity - production and sale of decorative items to support marginalized citizens.

Culture of European nations - performances by music bands and folklore groups.

Tour of the attractions of the Lower Pohronie region - awareness-raising activity.

The traditions of the Strekov region associated with the sale of products from the creative workshop of solidarity.

Active with seniors - workshop for older generations about the EU and programs for seniors in individual countries. Exchange of examples of good practice in active aging.

Culture of national minorities - performances of Roma and Hungarian minority groups.

The basis for the future - a discussion on the future direction of partnership and mutual assistance in the time of the corona crisis.
